## DAY 1

### Arrival in host families in Paris

## DAY 2

### Excursion to Paris

Free visit in Montmartre area and the Place du Tertre where you will like to stroll along the narrow cobblestone streets of old Paris while taking in the historical and cultural atmosphere.

Free visit of the Sacré Coeur Basilica, church built by a national vow after the defeat in 1870. Finished in 1914, it was consecrated in 1919 after the victory of France over Germany.

Guided tour of the perfume museum.

## DAY 3

### Excursion to Paris

Visit of the Louvre Museum, the most visited art museum. The collection contains nearly 35,000 pieces including Leonardo Da Vinci's famous Mona Lisa.

Walk in the Tuileries Gardens. A delight at any season of the year, it's the perfect place for a relaxing stroll and offer a range of activities for visitors of all ages.

Walk at the Place de la Concorde, one of the major public squares in Paris.

Discovery of the «Champs Elysées». Walk and shopping on one of the world's most famous avenue.

## DAY 4

### Excursion to Paris

Lift to the top of Eiffel Tower, to 317 meters with an amazing view of Paris.

Cruise on the river Seine, on a typical fly boat to enjoy a leisure cruise through the heart of the capital and enjoy spectacular view of the main monuments.

### Excursion to London

Changing of the Guards at 11.30 at Buckingham Palace.

Visit of the Museum of London, with over 2000 years of the capital's history from prehistoric to modern times. The Museum of London brings alive all aspects of London living through the ages.

### Excursion to London

Visit of the British Museum, hosting Egyptian, Greek and Roman antiques.

Shopping in Oxford street.

## DAY 8

### Excursion to London

Discovery of Big Ben. The Clock Tower is the world's largest four-faced, chiming clock. It is situated at the north-eastern end of the Houses of Parliament building in Westminster.

Discovery of Picadilly Circus Hectic traffic junction surrounded by shopping malls.

Discovery of Trafalgar Square area and shopping at Covent Garden.

Visit of Westminster Abbey. The fabulous façade of Westminster Abbey is unmissable. Dating from 1066, it is the number one church of the Anglican faith and coronation and burial place of British monarchs. Its most famous spots are Poets' Corner and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.
