DAY 2

Excursion in Strasbourg

Visit of the Council of Europe. It is the continent's oldest political organisation, founded in 1949. Visit of the Human Rights Palace to discover European Court of Human Rights and understand how it works.

Visit of the "Lieu d'Europe", place of education in European citizenship open to all, which vocation is to make Europe known to citizens and to strengthen their feeling of belonging to a community of values.

DAY 3

Excursion in Strasbourg

Visit of Strasbourg Cathedral, the 2nd highest gothic cathedral of France. Visit of Palais Rohan, the former residence of the prince-bishops of the House of Rohan, an ancien French noble family originally from Brittany, and is a major architectural, historical and cultural landmark in the city. Discovering of La Petite France area, the historical part of Strasbourg with all its typical houses and shops.

DAY 4

Excursion in Strasbourg

Visit of the Alsatian Museum of art and folk tradition, offering museum visitors a charming tour of Strasbourg's old houses linked together via staircases and wooden passageways. Discover the Vauban Dam, a bridge weir and defensive work, erected in the 17th century. Discover the «Kaiserplatz», built in the 19th century by german authorities to join the modern and the historical parts of the city around the 5 main monuments of the city.
